Sharonda joined Fishman Haygood as Special Counsel in December 2015 following a distinguished career in public service and private practice. Sharonda served as City Attorney for the City of New Orleans from May 2013-November 2015. As City Attorney, Sharonda was the lead attorney handling the most comprehensive police consent decree in the history of the United States. At the same time, she represented the City in another consent decree aimed at reforming the Orleans Parish Jail, which was then-recognized as one of the worst prisons in America. Both consent decrees required Sharonda to engage in negotiations with the United States Department of Justice on a near daily basis.

This webinar follows a previous installment covering insights on how law enforcement is trained, special considerations that arise during their prosecution, and solutions for the problems faced by prosecutors.
